Eagle Scout is the highest advancement rank in Boy Scouting.

In 2010, 56,176 Scouts earned the rank of Eagle Scout.

Around 5 percent of all Boy Scouts earned the Eagle Scout rank in 2010.

In 2010, the average age of boys earning the Eagle Scout rank was 17 years of age. From 1912 to 2010, more than 2 million Boy Scouts earned the Eagle Scout rank.



To earn the rank, a Boy Scout must:

Progress through the ranks in the following order:

Tenderfoot Second Class First Class Star Life Eagle

► Earn 21 merit badges, including:

First Aid Citizenship in the Community Citizenship in the Nation Citizenship in the World Communications Environmental Science Personal Fitness Camping Family Life Personal Management Emergency Preparedness or Lifesaving Cycling, Hiking, or Swimming

- ► Serve six months in a troop leadership position.
- ▶ Plan, develop, and give leadership to a service project for any religious organization or any school or communit
- ▶ Take part in a Scoutmaster conference.
- Successfully complete an Eagle Scout board of review.

Boy Scouts with disabilities may qualify for the Eagle Scout rank by fulfilling alternative requirements as determined by their council.

In the month of December 2011 (on December 6th) it was Troop 208's honor to recognize our own Scott!! He completed all of the requirements listed above successfully and that includes one heavy stone wall we built.
