Awards & Recognitions & Training Info

AQUATICS STAND UP PADDLEBOARDING



Stand Up Paddleboarding (SUP) has been approved as a new aquatics award. Similar to Kayaking BSA, the award has requirements that introduce a Scout to the sport, and can easily be earned at summer camp or on a troop outing. This award will encourage Scouts to develop paddling skills that promote fitness and safe aquatics recreation.

Stand up paddleboarding should be taught on calm, flat water protected from waves, wind, and boat traffic. Only people who have successfully completed the BSA swimmer test in the current year may participate in stand up paddling. Other guidelines include the following:

A responsible adult must supervise all stand up paddling activities. The supervising adult must be trained in BSA Safety Afloat and be experienced and qualified in water safety (BSA Lifeguard, Red Cross Advanced Lifesaving, or YMCA Senior Lifesaver).

All people must wear an approved U.S. Coast Guard personal flotation device (Type III recommended) at all times.

An appropriate style of leash must be worn in the appropriate venues.

No one paddles alone or at night, and paddles within swimming distance of shore



- 1. Successfully complete the BSA swimmer test.
- 2. Describe various types of kayaks and how they differ in design, materials, and purpose.

 Name the parts of the kayak you are using for this exercise.

 Demonstrate how to choose an appropriately sized kayak paddle and how to position your hands.
- 3. Tell what precautions must be taken for a safe trip afloat.

Demonstrate how to select and properly fit a PFD.

Explain the importance of safety equipment such as PFDs, air bags, grab loops, and helmets.

4. Demonstrate your ability to aid yourself and others in the event of a capsize:

Capsize your kayak in water at least seven feet deep, perform a wet exit if necessary, and swim the boat to shore.

With assistance, if needed, ready the capsized craft for use.

Show how to approach a capsized paddler in your kayak and tow him to shore.

While upright in your kayak, right a capsized kayak, empty it of water, and assist the paddler aboard without returning to shore

5. As a solo paddler, demonstrate the following:

Entering and launching a kayak from shore or dock

Landing or docking and exiting a kayak

Forward stroke Draw stroke
Sweep stroke Rudder stroke

Reverse sweep Back stroke

6. As a solo paddler, do the following:

Paddle forward in a reasonably straight line.

Move the kayak sideways to the right and to the left.

Pivot 360 degrees to the right and left.

Stop the kayak.

August Historical & Current Events

August 1st

The first article proposing women's rights in America was written by Thomas Paine for the *Pennsylvania Magazine*, of which he was the editor, 1775.

Anne Frank's last diary entry, 1944

August 3rd

This day, Congress designated June 14 as Flag Day, 1949 The Strategic Arms Limitation Treaty was passed, 1972

August 4th

During WWII, Gestapo captured Anne Frank, her family and others, in Holland, 1944 The United States Department of Energy was created, 1977

August 5th

The Rock and Roll Hall of Fame was established, 1985.

August 7th

George Washington created the "Purple Heart," decoration medal, 1782

The United States War Department was established by Congress, with Henry Knox as the first secretary of war, 1789

August 8th

Thomas Edison received a patent for his mimeograph, 1876

August 9th

The steamboat *Erie*, caught on fire on Lake Erie, killing 175, 1841.

August 10th

The first commercial electric streetcar in America and the world was placed into operation in Baltimore. It ran from Oak Street to Roland Avenue to 40th Street.

August 12th

The United States Postal system became independent, 1970 Isaac Merrit Singer was granted a patent for his sewing machine, 1851

August 13th

The coin operated telephone was patented, 1889

August 14th

The Social Security Act was passed by Congress, 1935

August 16th

The first cable message was sent across the Atlantic Ocean from Queen Victoria of England to United States President James Buchanan, 1858

August 18th

President Abraham Lincoln first test fired the new Spencer Carbine rifle, 1863.

Mount Whitney, the second highest mountain in the United States, was scaled for the first time by an American team consisting of John Lucas, Charles D. Begole, and A.H. Johnson, 1873.

The world's first nuclear-powered ship, Savannah, made its maiden voyage from Yorktown, VA to Savannah, GA, 1962

August 29th

The Beatles concluded their fourth American tour with their last public concert at Candlestick Park, San Francisco, 1966

August 31st

Thomas A. Edison received a patent for his Kinetoscope, 1887.
