Awards & Recognitions & Training Info

A rare award, did you know that there are actually THREE *Congressional Medals of Honor*?

On Dec 9, 1861 Iowa Senator James W. Grimes introduced S. No 82 in the US Senate, a bill designed to "promote the efficiency of the Navy" by the production and distribution of "medals of honor". On December 21st the bill was passed, authorizing 200 such medals be produced "which upon such petty officers, seamen, landsmen and marines as shall distinguish themselves by their gallantry in action and other seamanlike qualities during the present war (Civil War)." President Lincoln signed the bill and the (Navy) Medal of Honor was born.









US Army US Navy/Marines US Air Force Two months later on Feb 17, 1862 Massachusetts Senator Henry Wilson introduced a similar bill, this one to authorize "the President to distribute medals to privates in the Army of the United States who shall distinguish themselves in battle." Over the following months wording changed slightly as the bill way through Congress. When President Abraham Lincoln signed S.J.R. No. 82 on July 12, 1862, the Army Medal of Honor was born.

"When in the course of human events, it becomes necessary for one people to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the laws of nature and of nature's God entitle them, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation."

These words are the beginning of the unanimous Declaration of the 13 united *States of America*, our Declaration of Independence from Great Britain. There are many websites everyone can go to (such as www.ushistory.com for one) with the history of this day. Take a moment, maybe as a family, to consider that our country has many rights and freedoms that other people in the rest of the world only dream for. We have had our democracy since 1776 and we still are working to improve our society - something our Scouts will be able to continue to do.

The Recruiter award has no formal requirements established by the Boy Scouts of America. It is awarded by the Cubmaster or Scoutmaster to a Cub Scout or Boy Scout who is successful in getting a friend, relative, classmate. or other acquaintance to ioin his unit. ONE patch can be awarded to a boy while he is a Cub Scout, and another may be awarded while he is a Boy Scout or Varsity Scout. Bring your friends guys!

Religious Emblems, cloth, silver knot on purple may be worn by youth or adult members who earned the knot as a youth member, above left pocket. Each faith has its own requirements for earning its emblem. A knot device may be used to indicate during which level of Scouting the award was earned. This award may be earned by all registered Tiger, Wolf, Bear, and Webelos Scouts.

These programs are a great opportunity for young men (or women) to learn more about their faith!
