Purpose

To recognize adult Scouters for their outstanding contributions to the District's Camping Program.

Guidelines

Nominations can be made by any registered Scouter. Nominations should be given to a member of the District Camping Committee. The District Camping Committee will select the recipient(s) of the award.

The nominee should

have at least one year of service to Swan Creek Distric,
be a registered adult (Cub Scout, Boy Scout, Exploring, Venture Crew) from Swan Creek District,
have made exceptional contribution to the District during the past year (or years),
meet the ideals of the Twelve Points of the Scout Law such as being cheerful, courteous, and
helpful towards others.

The name of Bob Stevens was always associated with the adventure of Scouting and the recipient should have this "Spirit of Adventure".

This award can only be earned once and is not dependent upon or to be influenced by other awards.

All nominations should be submitted by the March District Committee Meeting. This meeting is the first Thursday of the each month per the District's calendar. This will enable the District Camping Committee adequate time to review the nominations, select the recipient(s) and properly prepare the recognition for the District Recognition & Awards Dinner in May.
